Location Knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Name and locate the world's continents and oceans
Place Knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The locality of the school
Human and Physical Geography	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom• Use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic physical features
Geographical skills and fieldwork	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use simple compass directions (North, South, East and West) and locational language (e.g. <i>near and far</i>) to describe the location of features and routes on a map• Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment• Devise simple maps and use and construct basic symbols in a key
