What a fabulous time we had last Wednesday when we all join together at Vale Royal Abbey for our whole school picnic (minus the Acorns who had only just started full days). After eating lunch, we thought about the importance of the abbey and how the construction of it led to the settlement here which is now Whitegate village. We then spent some time sketching the current building which was built in the 1540s using the original stone, after the earlier abbey was closed by Henry VIII during the dissolution of the Monasteries. How wonderful to have such history on our doorstep!

It is such a lovely walk from here to the abbey. Can I encourage you to park there and walk either to or from school, or both, with your children to get to school. As well as getting some fresh air and exercise, it would help with congestion in the village.

Uniform

As previously communicated, I would like to thank the vast majority who are following our policy. I would like to take this opportunity to confirm that the policy has not changed. In fact, I have gone back as far as 2010 to check this - I cannot find a policy which pre-dates this. The only change that has taken place since then was the introduction, and then removal, of the navy zip through hoodie. The purchase of a Whitegate PE hoodie is optional: your child may wear their jumper or cardigan with logo.

On PE days, children are to wear either navy shorts or jogging bottoms; again, this isn't new. Please do not allow your child to come to school in leggings or skorts.
