



Key Facts	Vocabulary dozen			Delving into the Ocean	
<p>Five connected oceans cover up part of the Earth's crust.</p> <p>- The Pacific, the Atlantic, Indian, Southern, and Arctic.</p>	<p>1. Ocean:</p> <p>A large expanse of sea that has been divided up and shared. e.g. The Pacific Ocean.</p> 	<p>5. Tidal zone:</p> <p>This is the land between high and low tide. Creatures here burrow into the sand or mud, or attach themselves to rocks.</p>	<p>9. Anglerfish:</p> <p>Frightening looking fish with sharp teeth. They have a light hanging in front of their heads to help them see.</p> 		
<p>There are 4 zones in the ocean:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tidal zone 2. Sunlight zone 3. Twilight zone 4. Deep sea zone 	<p>2. Mountain:</p> <p>A large natural elevation of the Earth's surface.</p> 	<p>6. Sunlight zone:</p> <p>0-200 metres deep. Where most wildlife is found.</p>	<p>10. Koi carp:</p> <p>Japanese fish that look like they have a thin moustache.</p> 		
<p>People have fished the ocean for thousands of years. Nearly all fish is edible to humans including cod, salmon, tuna, mackerel, haddock and plaice.</p>	<p>3. Fog:</p> <p>Thick cloud of tiny water droplets close to the ground. Makes it hard to see ahead.</p> 	<p>7. Twilight zone:</p> <p>200-2,000 metres. Light fades the lower you go.</p>	<p>11. Jellyfish:</p> <p>Sea creatures with stinging tentacles. They don't have brains and can glow in the dark!</p> 		
<p>All ocean life depends on plankton. Plankton can be either animal or plant. You cannot see plankton without a microscope as it is so small.</p>	<p>4. Shore:</p> <p>The land along the edge of a sea, lake, or other large body of water.</p> 	<p>8. Deep sea zone:</p> <p>2,000-10,000 meters. Deep down, the water is very cold and there is no light.</p>	<p>12. Clown fish:</p> <p>Commonly recognised as 'Nemo'. They live in the sunlight zone.</p>
