This year, the PTA was able to fund several impactful projects, including:

- Artificial Grass: Making the playground and surrounding areas accessible whatever the weather £14,205.17
- Colour Run: £279.08 Ran as a fun activity for the children
- Reserves built ready to fund the new build

These contributions have significantly improved the school environment and enhanced the children's school experience.

# 6. Challenges and Considerations

While we have had a successful year, there are a few challenges to keep in mind:

- Event Participation: While some events were highly successful, we noticed a slight decline in
  participation in others. We may need to diversify our activities and improve promotion next
  year. Some activities were close together and there were clusters of times when we were
  asking parents to fund multiple things at the same time.
- Grants and Donations: Securing additional grants will assist our fundraising goals. We have exhausted grants that will fund building works so we now need to look to fund other needs of our school community e.g learning resources.

 Volunteers: The PTA is limited in its ability to raise more funds due to the lack of volunteer engagement.

Next year, we aim to:

- Explore new and innovative fundraising ideas.
- Increase community engagement and volunteer participation.
- We also welcome any suggestions from PTA members and parents on how to further enhance our efforts and contributions to Whitegate Primary School.
